When Dafty seeks revenge against the local schoolmaster for a punishment inflicted on Banjo, life becomes suddenly more serious. Jack's Island offers young readers a valuable insight into life in Australia during the war, told from the perspective of a young boy.

In Flanders Fields (illustrated by Brian Harrison-Lever)

Early on Christmas morning the guns stop firing. A deathly silence creeps over the pitted and ruined landscape. A young soldier peers through a periscope over the top of the trench. Way out in no-man's-land, he sees a robin trapped in barbed wire. One wing is flapping helplessly. An eloquent counterpoint to the senselessness and inhumanity of war, *In Flanders Fields* tells the story of a young homesick World War I soldier, who risks his life to cross no-man's land and rescue a robin caught in the barbed wire that separates the opposing forces.
