**Good Standing Policy**

## RATIONALE

At Kellerberrin District High School, we believe in the *Keller Way*. This means that all members of our school community value respect, engagement, resilience and safety in a welcoming, inclusive, collaborative and caring environment. We encourage students to make positive choices to avoid negative consequences. The *Keller Way* emphasises the importance of taking responsibility for any negative choices students may make which ultimately affects their learning and the learning of others.

## WHAT IS GOOD STANDING?

All students commence the year with Good Standing. Maintaining Good Standing requires the students to fully adhere to the Keller Way Behaviour Matrix as well as our school's dress code requirements.

The Keller Way outlines behaviours linking to:

- Respect
- Engagement
- Resilience, and;
- Safety

Students who maintain their Good Standing will be eligible to fully participate in:

- Incursions
- Excursions
- Sports carnivals
- Interschool carnivals
- And will have opportunity to represent our school at other activities and events
- Camps
- Extracurricular programs and activities
- End of year dinners and graduations

## WITHDRAWING GOOD STANDING

VIOLATION	DESCRIPTION	ACTION
<b>Dress Code</b>	A student who is reported for arriving at school out of uniform more than three (3) times.	A loss of Good Standing for a period of four (4) weeks.
<b>Behaviour</b>	More than three reported behaviour incidences (recorded on SIS) in a term.	Loss of Good Standing for a period of four (4) weeks.
<b>Suspension</b>	A suspension resulting from severe breach of Keller Way Behaviour Matrix.	Loss of Good Standing for a period of four (4) weeks.

A loss of Good Standing will result in students not being able to attend any extra-curricular activities including: incursions, excursions, sporting carnivals, camps, rewards, socials and any other type of school representation. Parents/Caregivers will be notified when a student loses their Good Standing.

The Good Standing Policy is provided to maintain consistency in our decision making processes. It is important to note that these are guidelines and if there are extenuating circumstances that have resulted in the negative behaviours or a student has special needs these factors will be taken into account and any decision to withdraw or maintain Good Standing will be at the discretion of the Principal.

## GOOD STANDING PROCESS

GOOD STANDING - Student demonstrates the behaviours and values as outlined in the Keller Way Behaviour Matrix.

Student is exhibiting behaviours that are in breach of the Keller Way Behaviour Matrix.

Teachers will:

- Inform parents /carers
- Conference with the student
- Inform SAER coordinator
- Develop and share BMP
- Record behaviour incidences and communications on SIS

Student is regularly attending school out of uniform.

Teachers will:

- Inform parents /carers
- Conference with the student
- Provide uniform to the student to change in to during school hours
- Record incidences and communications on SIS

Student makes a severe breach of Keller Way Behaviour Matrix and is suspended.

Principal/Deputy:

- Inform parents/carers
- Develop and share re-entry plan

SAER Coordinator will:

- Call for Case Conference with all stakeholders
- Develop and share Good Standing contract

Student continues to exhibit behaviours that are in breach of the Keller Way Behaviour Matrix and has more than three reported behaviour incidences (recorded on SIS) in a term.
