The Kellerberrin District High School Board has endorsed the schedule of Voluntary Contributions and Charges for 2023. The schedule is broken into sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that might occur throughout the 2023 school year.

1. **CONTRIBUTIONS** – The School Education Act sets that maximum amount of Voluntary Contributions cannot exceed \$60 per child from Kindergarten to Year 6 and \$235 for Years 7-10 students. Money collected will be used to supplement school expenditure in a range of curriculum areas. While Contributions are voluntary, the quality of our teaching and learning program will be maximised when each family makes its contribution. **This amount is highlighted on the invoice overleaf and is due for payment as soon as possible.**
2. **CHARGES FOR EXTRA COST OPTIONAL COMPONENTS** - A breakdown of estimated charges for your child's participation in excursions, incursions, activities, extra curricula resources etcetera for 2023 has been included in the invoice overleaf. Children will only incur costs when they are involved in a particular activity. The amounts indicated on the schedule represent the estimated maximum for activities planned in 2023. **Do not pay this amount now, families will be asked to make payment for each activity as it approaches.**
3. **PERSONAL ITEMS REQUIREMENTS** – The costs for these items vary from student to student. The requirements for each student are contained in the year level book list. Parents can purchase these items from their store of choice. **All items are required at the commencement of the 2023 school year.**
4. **PAYMENT OPTIONS** – Payment can be made via the following methods:
